### **Public Disclosure of Data Has Always Been CAPA Policy**

WASHINGTON, DC – The Certified Automotive Parts Association announces that the raw test data which was compiled for both of its Lighting Studies is available by request through the CAPA website.

“This detailed backup data was requested by the lighting manufacturers and has been provided,” said Jack Gillis, Executive Director of CAPA. “As the nation’s only independent, third party, ANSI approved crash parts standard setting organization, we have always believed in full disclosure and these report results are certainly no exception,” said Gillis.
