Y.C.C. JOINS CAPA LIGHTING PROGRAM

Washington D.C. – The Certified Automotive Parts Association (CAPA) announces that Y.C.C. Parts Manufacturing Co., Ltd., headquartered in Chung Hua Hsien, Taiwan, has joined the CAPA Lighting program. Founded in 1986, Y.C.C. manufactures automotive plastic parts and lighting for the North and South American, European, and Asian markets. Y.C.C. became a Full Participant in the CAPA program in 1999. Y.C.C.'s lighting parts will be marketed as “Sunny, by Y.C.C.”
