CAPA Tops 85 Million Certified Parts

Washington D.C. – The Certified Automotive Parts Association (CAPA), the global leader in aftermarket part certification, announces the certification of over 85 million parts. This number represents the total number of parts CAPA has certified since 1990.

CAPA 301 Lighting Parts	Headlamps, Taillamps	10,000,000
CAPA 501 Bumper Parts	Front/Rear Bumpers, Energy Absorbers	1,000,000
